## Unblocking the file

## **Trusted Locations**

Alternatively, you can add the folder where you download files into (usually "Downloads") into Excel's **Trusted Locations**. Once set, Excel will not show you the message for the files located in that folder.

Be warned that, if you moved the file a folder that isn't a *trusted folder* and run, you see the message.

Follow the steps to get rid of Microsoft has blocked macros message:

Open Excel options by following File > Options. Open Trust Center Click Trust Center Settings In Trust Center window, activate Trusted Locations Click Add new location button to open Microsoft Office Trusted Location

1. Use **Browse** button to select the folder.

2. Click **OK** buttons to apply the setting.
